

Imaging Scheduling & Location Guide

Houston Methodist Baytown - for urology imaging orders

Call Imaging Scheduling: 832-556-6300

1. The clinic places the order

Your urology clinic sends the imaging order to the Houston Methodist system. The imaging appointment is **not automatically scheduled by the clinic**.

2. Please schedule the test

The hospital imaging team may call you to help schedule, but they may only call once. Please answer calls from Houston Methodist. If you miss the call, do not receive a call, or are unsure, call **832-556-6300**.

3. Complete imaging before follow-up

Please schedule early enough for the imaging to be completed before your follow-up visit. If the imaging cannot be completed in time, call or send a MyChart message to the urology clinic to ask whether your follow-up should be moved.

4. Where the imaging is usually done

Most CT scans, ultrasounds, and MRIs are done at the Outpatient Center (OPC):

Some advanced tests, such as PET scans, and some evening/weekend appointments may be done inside the **Main Hospital**: 4401 Garth Road. Imaging scheduling will tell you the exact check-in location.

How to read the campus map

W. Baker Road is across the top of the map. The Outpatient Center is on the left side of the campus, across the large main parking area/garage area from the Main Hospital. **Garth Road is on the right side of the map.**

A parking shuttle is available from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. to be picked up or dropped off from your vehicle. Call **346.292.1890** for assistance.

Look for signs for **Outpatient Center / OPC, Breast Care Center, Outpatient Lab, or Outpatient Surgery**. For Main Hospital imaging, follow signs for the Main Hospital / Unity Tower check-in area unless scheduling gives different instructions.

Tip: Ask imaging scheduling to confirm both the appointment time and the exact building/check-in desk before you hang up.
